## Riverview School District No. 407 King County February 24, 2014

#### ABOUT THE AUDIT

This report contains the results of our independent accountability audit of Riverview School District No. 407 from September 1, 2012 through August 31, 2013.

We evaluated internal controls and performed audit procedures on the activities of the District. We also determined whether the District complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures.

In keeping with general auditing practices, we do not examine every transaction, activity or area. Instead, the areas examined were those representing the highest risk of noncompliance, misappropriation or misuse. The following areas were examined during this audit period:

- Financial condition
- Sick and vacation leave payout
- Third party cash receipting

- Student enrollment reporting
- Student transportation reporting

#### **RESULTS**

In the areas we examined, the District's internal controls were adequate to safeguard public assets. The District also complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures in the areas we examined.

#### ABOUT THE DISTRICT

Riverview School District serves the communities of Carnation, Duvall and approximately 250 square miles in eastern King County. The District operates one high school, one middle school, three elementary schools and three alternative learning programs that serve approximately 3,000 students in preschool through 12th grade.

An elected, five-member Board of Directors governs the District. The Board appoints management to oversee the District's daily operations as well as its approximately 370 employees. For fiscal year 2013, the District operated on an annual budget of approximately \$29 million.
