ABOUT THE AUDIT

This report contains the results of our independent accountability audit of North Franklin School District No. J51-162 from September 1, 2012 through August 31, 2013.

We evaluated internal controls and performed audit procedures on the activities of the District. We also determined whether the District complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures.

In keeping with general auditing practices, we do not examine every transaction, activity or area. Instead, the areas examined were those representing the highest risk of noncompliance, misappropriation or misuse. The following areas were examined during this audit period:

- Transportation apportionment
- Credit cards and accounts

- Staff mix apportionment
- Procurement

RESULTS

In the areas we examined, the District's internal controls were adequate to safeguard public assets. The District also complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures in the areas we examined.

ABOUT THE DISTRICT

North Franklin School District No. J51-162 provides educational services to approximately 2,000 students in northern Franklin County. The District operates one high school, one alternative high school, one junior high school and three elementary schools. The District staffs Camp Outlook, an alternative to juvenile detention centers and North Franklin Virtual Academy, an alternative learning experience program.

A five-member Board of Directors governs the District. Board Members are elected to staggered, four-year terms. The Board appoints a Superintendent to oversee the District's daily operations and its approximately 300 full- and part-time employees. For fiscal year 2012-2013, the District had an annual general fund operating budget of approximately \$20.6 million.
