ABOUT THE AUDIT

This report contains the results of our independent accountability audit of Snoqualmie Valley School District No. 410 from September 1, 2012 through August 31, 2013.

We evaluated internal controls and performed audit procedures on the activities of the District. We also determined whether the District complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures.

In keeping with general auditing practices, we do not examine every transaction, activity or area. Instead, the areas examined were those representing the highest risk of noncompliance, misappropriation or misuse. The following areas were examined during this audit period:

- Associated Student Body activities
- Transportation
- Procurement

RESULTS

In the areas we examined, the District's internal controls were adequate to safeguard public assets. The District also complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures in the areas we examined.

ABOUT THE DISTRICT

Snoqualmie Valley School District No. 410 is located in the foothills of the Cascade Mountains and covers 400 square miles serving the communities of Snoqualmie, North Bend and Fall City and surrounding areas of unincorporated King County. The District serves about 6,300 students and families with five elementary schools, two middle schools, one comprehensive high school and one alternative school.

An elected, five-member Board of Directors governs the District. The Board appoints the Superintendent to oversee the District's daily operations as well as its 643 employees. For fiscal year 2013, the District operated on an annual budget of approximately \$74.7 million.
