ABOUT THE AUDIT

This report contains the results of our independent accountability audit of Northshore School District No. 417 from September 1, 2011 through August 31, 2013.

We evaluated internal controls and performed audit procedures on the activities of the District. We also determined whether the District complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures.

In keeping with general auditing practices, we do not examine every transaction, activity or area. Instead, the areas examined were those representing the highest risk of noncompliance, misappropriation or misuse. The following areas were examined during this audit period:

- Student transportation reporting
- Staff mix
- Bond expenditures
- Procurement public works
- Procurement sole source
- Property sale City of Bothell
- Catering revenues

ABOUT THE DISTRICT

Northshore School District No. 417 serves approximately 20,240 students in a 60 square-mile area of northeast King County and south Snohomish County. The District has 20 elementary schools, six junior high schools, three high schools and an alternative high school. In addition, the District has an early childhood center, a kindergarten through 12th grade home school program, a preschool and prekindergarten program.

An elected, five-member Board of Directors governs the District. The Board appoints a Superintendent to oversee the District's daily operations as well as its approximately 2,300 employees. For fiscal years 2011-2012 and 2012-2013, the District's general fund operating budgets were approximately \$186 million and \$188 million, respectively.
