#### ABOUT THE AUDIT

This report contains the results of our independent accountability audit of Highline School District No. 401 from September 1, 2012 through August 31, 2013.

We evaluated internal controls and performed audit procedures on the activities of the District. We also determined whether the District complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures.

In keeping with general auditing practices, we do not examine every transaction, activity or area. Instead, the areas examined were those representing the highest risk of noncompliance, misappropriation or misuse. The following areas were examined during this audit period:

- Teacher education and experience (staff mix) reporting
- Student transportation reporting

#### RESULTS

In the areas we examined, the District's internal controls were adequate to safeguard public assets. The District also complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures in the areas we examined.

#### ABOUT THE DISTRICT

Highline School District No. 401 serves a 43.8 square-mile area including the cities of Burien, Normandy Park and SeaTac and portions of the city of Des Moines and unincorporated King County. The District serves approximately 19,000 students in kindergarten through 12th grade and operates two comprehensive high schools, eight smaller learning community high schools, four middle schools, 18 elementary schools, one vocational skills center, one aviation high school, an outdoor camp and a learning center.

An elected, five-member Board of Directors governs the District. The Board appoints a Superintendent to oversee the District's daily operations as well as its 2,000 employees. For fiscal year 2013, the District's governmental funds revenue was approximately \$222 million.

#### **AUDIT HISTORY**

We audit the District annually. The District has received seven findings in the last five years. These findings included two regarding the reporting of excused absences and the others regarding enrollment reporting, staff mix reporting, financial reporting, federal Davis-Bacon requirements and time and effort reporting requirements. All findings have been resolved.

District officials and management have routinely taken steps to make improvements and follow our recommendations.
