AUDIT SUMMARY

Results in brief

In the areas we audited, Authority operations complied with applicable requirements and provided adequate safeguarding of public resources. The Authority also complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures in the areas we examined.

About the audit

This report contains the results of our independent accountability audit of the Housing Authority of Island County from October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2015.

Management is responsible for ensuring compliance and adequate safeguarding of public resources from fraud, loss or abuse. This includes the design, implementation and maintenance of internal controls relevant to these objectives.

Our audit involved performing procedures to obtain evidence about the Authority's uses of public resources, compliance with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures, and internal controls over such matters.

In keeping with general auditing practices, we do not examine every transaction, activity or area. Instead, the areas examined were those representing the highest risk of fraud, loss, abuse, or noncompliance. The following areas were examined during this audit period:

- Open Public Meetings Act
- Tax credit partnerships
- General disbursements
- Payment in lieu of taxes

Financial

A financial statement audit was performed by a firm of certified public accountants. That firm's report is available from Housing Authority of Island County.

Federal grant programs

A firm of certified public accountants evaluated internal controls and tested compliance with the federal program requirements, as applicable, for the Authority's major federal program. That firm's report is available from Housing Authority of Island County.

INFORMATION ABOUT THE AUTHORITY

The Housing Authority of Island County was incorporated in 1965 to provide safe, decent, sanitary and affordable housing to low-income and elderly people in Island County.

The Authority is governed by a six-member Board of Commissioners appointed by the Island County Board of Commissioners. The Board appoints an Executive Director to oversee the Authority's daily operations as well as its eight employees.

For the years ended September 30, 2014 and September 30, 2015, the Authority had annual operating/grant revenue of \$2,785,811 and \$2,766,549, and annual operating expenditures of \$2,961,783 and \$2,836,283, respectively.
