# **Audit Summary**

## City of Kelso Cowlitz County December 17, 2012

### ABOUT THE AUDIT

This report contains the results of our independent accountability audit of the City of Kelso from January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011.

We evaluated internal controls and performed audit procedures on the activities of the City. We also determined whether the City complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures.

In keeping with general auditing practices, we do not examine every transaction, activity or area. Instead, the areas examined were those representing the highest risk of noncompliance, misappropriation or misuse. The following areas were examined during this audit period:

- Indirect cost allocation plan
- Payroll and benefits
- Police Department
- Contract compliance and procurement

- Open Public Meetings Act
- Use of restricted resources
- Interfund transfers
- Financial condition

#### **RESULTS**

In most areas, the City complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures.

However, we noted certain matters that we communicated to City management. We appreciate the City's commitment to resolving those matters.

# **Description of the City**

## City of Kelso Cowlitz County December 17, 2012

### **ABOUT THE CITY**

The City of Kelso serves approximately 11,920 citizens in Cowlitz County. The City provides services including police, streets, sanitation, recreation, library, public improvements, planning and zoning, water supply treatment and distribution, sewage and storm-water collection and treatment, and a regional general aviation airport.

An elected, seven-member Council governs the City. The Council selects a Mayor from among its members to serve a two-year term. In addition, the Council appoints a Manager to oversee the City's day-to-day operations as well as its 70 employees. For fiscal year 2011, the City operated on an annual budget of approximately \$19 million.

### **AUDIT HISTORY**

We audit the City annually. The past five audits reported one area of concern. The 2007 audit contained an internal control finding over payment of federal prevailing wages. This finding has since been resolved. The City has not received an audit finding since 2007.
