ABOUT THE AUDIT

This report contains the results of our independent accountability audit of Everett School District No. 2 from September 1, 2012 through August 31, 2013.

We evaluated internal controls and performed audit procedures on the activities of the District. We also determined whether the District complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures.

In keeping with general auditing practices, we do not examine every transaction, activity or area. Instead, the areas examined were those representing the highest risk of noncompliance, misappropriation or misuse. The following areas were examined during this audit period:

- Cash receipting software review
- General disbursement system review
- Transportation ridership
- Access to District buildings

RESULTS

In the areas we examined, the District's internal controls were adequate to safeguard public assets. The District also complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures in the areas we examined.

ABOUT THE DISTRICT

Everett School District No. 2 provides educational services to students in preschool through 12th grade in Snohomish County. The District serves parts of the cities of Everett and Mill Creek and areas of unincorporated Snohomish County. During the audit period, the District served approximately 18,600 students at four high schools, five middle schools and 17 elementary schools.

An elected, five-member Board of Directors governs the District. Board Members serve staggered, six-year terms. The Board appoints a Superintendent to oversee the District's daily operations as well as its approximately 2,400 employees. The District operates on an operating budget of \$245 million.
