#### ABOUT THE AUDIT

This report contains the results of our independent accountability audit of the North Perry Avenue Water District from January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013.

We evaluated internal controls and performed audit procedures on the activities of the District. We also determined whether the District complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures.

In keeping with general auditing practices, we do not examine every transaction, activity or area. Instead, the areas examined were those representing the highest risk of noncompliance, misappropriation or misuse. The following areas were examined during this audit period:

• Utility billings/receipts

- Third party cash receipting
- Procurement/bid compliance

• Financial condition

#### **RESULTS**

In the areas we examined, the District's internal controls were adequate to safeguard public assets. The District also complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures in the areas we examined.

### **Description of the District**

#### **ABOUT THE DISTRICT**

The North Perry Avenue Water District was created in 1942 and serves approximately 7,700 metered connections. The District has approximately 100 miles of water mains, 14 active wells and seven storage reservoirs. The service area extends from the Bremerton city limits in the south to Keyport in the north. The present boundaries are defined by agreements with the city of Bremerton, Silverdale Water District, Kitsap County Public Utility District No. 1 and Aquarius Water District. The District provides water service and meter installations. In addition, the District charges each customer for street lighting provided by Puget Sound Energy.

An elected, three-member Board of Commissioners governs the District. The Board has appointed a General Manager to oversee the District's day-to-day operations. The District has 15 employees and had operating expenses of approximately \$2.8 million and \$2.9 million in fiscal years 2012 and 2013, respectively.
