ABOUT THE AUDIT

This report contains the results of our independent accountability audit of the Naches-Selah Irrigation District.

We performed audit procedures to determine whether the District complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures. We also examined District management's accountability for public resources. Our work focused on specific areas that have potential for abuse and misuse of public resources.

Areas examined during the audit were selected using financial transactions from January 1, 2002, through December 31, 2004.

RESULTS

The District complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures in the areas we examined. Internal controls were adequate to safeguard public assets.

Description of the District

Naches-Selah Irrigation District Yakima County October 17, 2005

ABOUT THE DISTRICT

The Naches-Selah Irrigation District provides irrigation services to approximately 1,600 parcels of land covering more than 10,500 acres in Yakima County. A three-member Board of Directors is elected to three-year terms by the District landowners. The Board appoints the Superintendent, who is responsible for managing the day-to-day operations. The District has eight full-time employees and 10-15 part-time workers. The District operates with an annual revenue base of approximately \$1 million.

AUDIT HISTORY

Typically, we audit the District every three years. The District has had no audit findings during the previous three audits, which covered the years 1994-2001.

In keeping with general auditing practices, we do not examine every portion of the Naches-Selah Irrigation District's financial activities during each audit.
